

Security Company Licence
Fees in respect of licences

The following licence fees will be applicable to licences —

- (a) issued under section 21A of the Security and Guarding Services Ordinance (*SGSO*) **on or after 17 July 2006**;
- (b) renewed under section 23 of the *SGSO* **on or after 17 July 2006** (i.e., licences with renewal dates fall on or after 17 July 2006); and
- (c) replacement of licences issued under section 25A of the *SGSO* **on or after 17 July 2006**.

Notes :

According to the *SGSO*

- 1. An application for a licence shall be accompanied by the prescribed fee.
- 2. A fee is payable by the applicant in respect of a licence issued as follows
 - (i) on the issue of the licence, the prescribed annual fee; and
 - (ii) on or before each successive anniversary of the date of issue of the licence during the term of the licence as issued, a fee equal to the fee that was payable on the issue of the licence under paragraph (i).
- 3. An application for the renewal of a licence shall be accompanied by the prescribed fee.
- 4. A fee is payable by the licensee in respect of the renewal of its licence as follows-
 - (i) on the renewal of the licence, the prescribed annual fee; and
 - (ii) on or before each successive anniversary of the date of renewal of the licence during the term of the licence as renewed, a fee equal to the fee that was payable on the renewal of the licence under paragraph (i).
- 5. Annual fee payable throughout the term of a licence is fixed on the date of issue/renewal of the licence and will **not** be affected by any fee adjustments during the term of the licence. (See Note 2(ii) above)
- 6. The Authority may, if satisfied that any licence has been lost, stolen, damaged or destroyed, issue a replacement of the licence to the licensee on payment of the prescribed fee.

According to the Security and Guarding Services (Fees) Regulation

- 7. The above fees shall be paid to the Security and Guarding Services Industry Authority.
- 8. If for any reason a licence ceases to be valid, no part of the fee paid under the above Regulation shall be refunded.
- 9. For the purposes of the above Regulation, a part of a year shall be counted as a whole year.

According to the Security and Guarding Services (Licensing) Regulation

- 10. If the licensee fails to pay the annual fee as required, its licence shall be revoked on the day following the due date for the payment of the fee.
